FEBRUARY 5, 2015: ROPE SAFETY FOR BOTTOMS (AND TOPS)

There is no better way to show your affection for your partner than by treating safety as a top priority. In this class we got over the basics of rope safety, from negotiation and interviewing your partner, to understanding anatomy and physiology as it relates to rope.

Rope safety is not just a physical concern, it is also about the emotional and psychological well being of your partner. This class covers all aspects of kinbaku safety and is aimed at both tops and bottoms. Come learn to protect yourself and your partner.

MARCH 5, 2015: EBI AND GYAKU EBI

This class will examine two classic kinbaku ties: the ebi or "shrimp" or "prawn" tie, once used as a torture tie in Edo-era Japan and the gyaku ebi or "reverse shrimp tie," the Japanese version of the western "hog tie."

In this class, we will teach you the basic techniques of performing this tie safely and effectively for pleasure, pain, endurance or eroticism.

APRIL 2, 2015: SABAKI: THE ART OF ROPE HANDLING

One of the most important aspects of tying effectively and with flow and emotion is knowing how to control, move and position your rope. This class will help you better understand how to control your rope and how to deal with issues of tension, position and even finishing your ties neatly and effectively.
